Colonial Crisis/flash point

Was the Mufti the mastermind? (No)

Could the British have mitigated disaster? Not by much (if at all).

Does intelligence affect the crisis? No but it could have led to longer term alternative outcomes.



Historical methods

I'm not saying that these counterfactuals represent scientific fact.

Wargaming is a more **rigorous** and more **collaborative** way to engage with counterfactuals.

Better than using intuition, alone.
